

Diocesan Convention Delegate Position Description

*Holy Trinity is a people passionately seeking
to love with the heart of Christ,
to think with the mind of Christ,
and to act in the world as the Body of Christ.*

A Delegate to the Diocesan Convention is Holy Trinity's representative to the convention.

Term of Office – Each of four delegates serves a **four (4)-year** term. One delegate is elected each year.

Qualifications

- Be 16 years of age or older.
- Be an active communicant of the Parish for at least 6 months.
- Be a pledging member of record.
- Be a confirmed Episcopalian or received by a bishop into the Episcopal Church from another Christian church.
- Participate in the Eucharist every Sunday "unless for good cause prevented."

Responsibilities

- Must attend the convention, currently held mid to late October.
- Attend quarterly meetings of the Foothills Convocation. (The convocation is a geographical grouping of congregations where mutual communication occurs about diocesan matters.)

An Alternate to Diocesan Convention must also be a communicant in good standing and should be prepared to attend the convention. Alternates are elected for a one year term.
