Splish-Splash Water Days May 24 & 25

We will be celebrating the beginning of summer with Splish-Splash Days, full of fun water activities on Thursday, May 24 and Friday, May 25. See Special Dates above for the date that your child's class will have their Splish-Splash Day. *The 3-Day 2K Blue Birds students are invited to attend on Thursday, May 24 from 10:30 a.m. -12:00 p.m. for Splish-Splash Day! Please send your child to school dressed in his/her bathing suit with a change of clothes, towel, shoes that can get wet (no flip flops) and a second pair of shoes to wear home. For safety reasons, children will not be allowed to go barefoot on the lawn. Apply sunblock before arriving at school. Also, make sure to put your child's name on his/her towel, water shoes, bathing suit, clothes, etc. Parents are invited to assist in supervising the children as they play on the lawn. Please come, if you are able to help on either of these days from 10:15 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Thursday, May 31 - Day at the Park for 5-Day 3K, 4K and ALL 2K Classes Barrett's Place Playground of Veterans Park in Pendleton

NO EARLY MORNING OR AFTER SCHOOL CARE ON May 31. DO NOT GO TO THE SCHOOL. DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP WILL BE AT THE PARK.

- DROP-OFF: Teachers will be in the playground parking lot to receive children from 8:45-9:00a.m. When you arrive, inform your child's teachers if you are staying or leaving. Do not leave your child without insuring that he/she has been signed-in by his/her teacher. If you arrive after 9:00 a.m., you will need to park your vehicle and walk through the playground to find your child's teachers.
- Students will be provided with a mid-morning snack at the park.
- PICK-UP: Teachers will be in the parking lot to load children into vehicles from 12:00p.m.-12:10p.m. A
 parent/approved caregiver must sign-out his/her child from his/her teacher before taking the child from the
 park.
- All parents are encouraged and welcome to stay. Extra supervision and helping hands will be needed and greatly appreciated.
- The **3-Day 2K Blue Bird students are invited** to join their friends at the park on May 31, since their class will not have a separate trip there.
- RAIN: A decision will be made by 8:00a.m. on May 31 if this activity must be cancelled due to rain. If there is a cancellation due to rain, we will open the school building for drop off at 8:45 a.m. and dismiss all students at 12:00 p.m.
