EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY

Is God calling you to go deeper in your faith by loving God with your mind? Education for Ministry (EfM) is a small group program for adults who desire to see God in every moment by gaining a deeper knowledge of scripture, church history, and theology. Groups are comprised of six to twelve adults, led by a mentor or two who guide and administer the group. Holy Trinity's EfM group meets on Monday evenings from 6:00pm to 8:30pm and we roughly follow the Clemson University class calendar from August to May. This year's mentors will be Jim Beddow and Anna McKenna, with regular cameo appearances by Mother Suz Cate. Our group has met online via Zoom for the past two years and we anticipate that will continue but a final decision on that will be made in late May.

Our EfM group will have two or three openings to begin in August, both for new students and for those who have completed part of the curriculum and wish to resume.
